

Christmas In Smithfield 2016 House Decorating Contest

Rules and Application Form

All houses within the Smithfield Historic District are eligible to participate but homeowners must fill out and submit this application to the Visitor Center by the deadline of 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, November 30, 2016 in order to enter. See details below.

There is no application fee.

Judging will take place on Friday morning (December 2, 2016) between 10:00 and 12:00 (noon) with ribbons awarded by approximately 1:00 PM.

There are three categories: Colonial/Federal, Victorian and Contemporary.

Houses and front doors will be decorated period appropriate for the house, i.e., a 18th century house will be decorated like one would have been in the 18th century.

- * All materials used should be completely natural and appropriate for the period of the house.
- * All decorations should be installed prior to the judging day (December 2).
- * Decorations can include the entire front of the house (not just the doorway) as long as it is period appropriate for the particular house.
- * Judges decisions are final and in the spirit of the Christmas season. The winners' ribbons will be carefully attached to the front door of their respective house by approximately 1:00 PM on the day of judging (Friday, December 2). No other notification or award will be provided. Houses will be judged from curbside only.
- * Ribbons will be awarded for: Best in Show for the overall competition, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each category.

Judges will look for the following criteria: Historically appropriate decorations for the house; use of natural elements; overall appearance and balance; complexity of decorations; artistic effect and originality.
